He was only passed by one competitor (although they traded positions a couple of times) but unfortunately that guy was also on an all-male team. Their runner ran a 19-minute 5k and they ended up with the gold. Rubie ran a bit quicker than last time, but between the two guys they couldn't beat the three-person team of males. Nevertheless, it was a great event. Mason's Polar CS600X bike computer showed him averaging 209 Watts on his ride and 161 bpm heart rate!
